#### New Leadership at the National Federation of Republican Women Headquarters

The Commonwealth Republican Women's Club members welcome the newly elected NFRW President Rae Chornenky to Alexandria and to the National Federation of Republican Women's headquarters at 124 N. Alfred Street. Rae was elected to serve as the NFRW President for

the 2012-2014 term at the NFRW fall biennial convention.

Chornenky is proud to be a native of Phoenix. A loyal Arizona State University alum, Chornenky earned a B.A., graduating magna cum laude; master's degree in counseling, and J.D. all from ASU. She has practiced law for 28 years. She currently owns her own business, making her sensitive to the issues of running a corporation.

Chornenky retired from the superior court bench in 1995 and went on to serve as a legislative attorney for an Arizona cabinet-level agency, drafting extensive legislation and successfully lobbying state budget issues, laws, and regulatory acts. She appeared in television, radio and print media, as well. She served as adjunct professor of constitutional law, substantive criminal law and evidence. Her private legal practice has included advising non-profit organizations, representing political candidates and campaign organizations, coordinating seminars and workshops, serving as a speaker on constitutional and political issues and the defense of individuals charged with crimes.



As a Republican, Rae has been elected precinct committeeman and sat on the executive committee of the state party. She has been a member of the NFRW since 1994. She had the privilege of attending the 1995 NFRW biennial convention and, since that "beginning," has continuously served on the NFRW Board of Directors, with the exception of one term.

Under Chornenky's leadership Valerie Dowling, NFRW Political Director who is also our CRWC Vice President, will be increasing NFRW involvement in GOP campaign efforts across the nation during 2012.

#### "Living Legends 2011": Fran and Gant Redmon

"Each person must live their life as a model for others" Rosa Parks

Fran and Gant Redmon have, together and individually, worked assiduously for the Republican Party and as advocates for the arts and business development in Alexandria. They thrive on doing. For example, making Republican events happen and succeed. CRWC members, in particular, have benefited from their generosity and commitment. And, their enthusiasm and ability have been well rewarded.

In 2011 Fran and Gant were recognized as "Living Legends" for their contributions to the arts in Alexandria, as well as their work with the American Red Cross Alexandria Chapter, the Historic Alexandria Foundation, the Hospice of Northern Virginia, the Alexandria Lawyers Auxiliary and the Alexandria Industrial Development Authority. Previously, in 2008, the University of Illinois named Fran and Gant Alumni of the Year, the first time the distinction was awarded to a married couple. The Redmons have been married for 53 years. For 37 of these years they have resided at "Tall Oaks," in Alexandria, where they have hosted fund-raising events for many causes.


In addition, Fran, with two other Alexandria women, created SPRINGboard, which provides professional experienced speakers for board development and training. For her work in mentorship of community arts organizations Fran was nominated for a national medal from the National Endowment of the Arts. In addition, Fran was awarded a citation "For Enhancing the Cultural Fabric of Alexandria through her Generosity and Dedicated Volunteer Service." This is her most treasured accolade.

At the same time, Gant has been a community activist supporting the arts, political causes and business development, as exemplified by his work for the Alexandria Rotary Club, the Alexandria Chamber of Commerce and the Alexandria and Virginia Bar Associations. He has served as the chairman of the Goodwin House Foundation since 2005. Gant is the managing partner of Redmon, Peyton & Braswell, LLP.

Both Gant and Fran have served on committees for five presidential inaugural balls and are patrons, members and advocates for over three dozen local arts organizations.

Together, Fran and Gant serve as models of how social connections, friendships, advocacy and purpose have made a significant difference to the quality of life in Alexandria.


#### In Memoriaum


There will be memorial service here at a later date when Betty Lou is able to travel.
