Now – Oct. 31. Voters may Request Absentee Ballots.

September 22, Friday. First day to vote "in person absentee" at the Voter Registration

Office, 132 N. Royal Street. Beginning October 28, you may also vote in-person at Beatley Library.

October 16, Monday. Voter Registration Deadline for Nov. 7 election.

October 31, Tuesday 5pm. Deadline to request absentee ballot by mail.

November 4, Saturday 5pm. Deadline to vote "in person absentee."

November 7, Tuesday 6am – 7pm ELECTION DAY. VOTE TODAY to Elect the full slate of GOP Candidates: Gillespie for Governor, Vogel for Lt. Governor, and Adams for Attorney General.

Reminder: Make sure your Pro-Life/conservative college kids request an absentee ballot if they will be away at college on Election Day!
